Associate Degree	462,000 บาท \$16,500
Post-Graduate Certificates/ Post-Graduate Diplomas	392,000 – 650,000 THB \$14,000 – \$24,000
Bachelor's Degree	509,600 – 700,000 THB \$18,000 – \$25,000
Master's Degree	308,000 – 1,300,000 THB \$11,000 – \$44,800

## ⌘ Intakes & Application Periods

<b>September Intake (Fall)</b>	Most popular intake. Applications typically open from January to March of the same year.
<b>January Intake (Winter)</b>	A secondary intake. Apply between June and September of the previous year.
<b>May Intake (Spring/Summer)</b>	Offered by select institutions. Apply 6–9 months in advance (August to November of previous year).

**Applying for a student visa (Study Permit) from Thailand takes approximately 12 weeks.**

## **⚙️ Application Preparation Tips**

- **Check your eligibility and gather all required documents (e.g., English proficiency scores such as IELTS/TOEFL, academic transcripts, and letters of recommendation)**
- **Complete the application form and submit it along with the application fee**
- **Prepare for an interview if it is part of the institution's admission process**
- **Begin the application process early to maximize your chances of acceptance**



## Required Documents for College/University Applications

### College

1. Valid passport
2. Academic transcripts
3. English proficiency test scores

### University

1. Valid passport
2. Academic transcripts
3. English proficiency test scores
4. Statement of Purpose (SOP)
5. 2–3 Recommendation Letters
6. Additional test scores if required (e.g., SAT, ACT, GMAT, GRE)





## ❖ Recommended Minimum Financial Proof for Visa



### **English Programs**

850,000 – 1,000,000 THB



### **Certificate or Diploma**

More than 1,000,000 THB



### **Bachelor's Degree**

More than 3,500,000 THB



### **Master's Degree**

More than 1,800,000 THB

It is recommended to prepare additional funds beyond the minimum amount required by the embassy, taking into account the total tuition fees and living expenses for the entire duration of the program .



## ❖ Preparing a Statement for a Student Visa Application

Programs	Duration	Recommended Minimum Financial Proof (THB)
English Language	7 – 12 months	850,000 – 1,000,0000
Certificate/ Diploma (Private Institutions, Co-Op)	6 months – 1 year	More than 1,200,0000
Certificate/ Diploma (Public Institutions, Co-Op)	1 year	More than 1,200,0000
Diploma/ Associate Degree (Public Institutions)	2 years	More than 1,800,0000
Bachelor's degree	3 – 4 years	More than 3,500,0000
Master's degree	2 – 3 years	More than 1,500,0000

## Working While Studying in Canada

Programs	Working in Canada
English Language	Not allow to work while studying
Certificate/ Diploma	Allow up to 24 hours/week during the academic term and 40 hours/week during scheduled breaks or co-op/internships
Diploma/ Associate Degree	Allow up to 24 hours/week during the academic term and 40 hours/week during scheduled breaks
Bachelor's degree	Allow up to 24 hours/week during the academic term and 40 hours/week during scheduled breaks
Master's degree	Allow up to 24 hours/week during the academic term and 40 hours/week during scheduled breaks
